



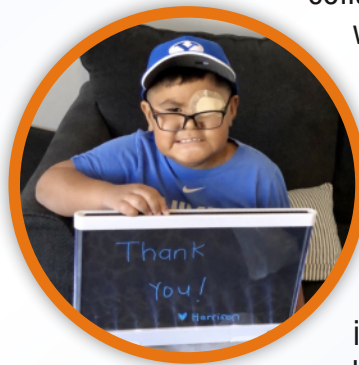
## RESEARCH PARTNER PROGRAM
